### REMARKS OF

### GOVERNOR THOMAS H. KEAN

PRESS CONFERENCE TO ANNOUNCE HIS CANDIDACY FOR RE-ELECTION

APRIL 2, 1985

NEW JERSEY HAS COME A LONG WAY IN THREE YEARS.

ON THE COLD JANUARY DAY WHEN I RAISED MY HAND TO BE

SWORN IN TO THIS GREAT OFFICE, NEW JERSEY FACED A TIME OF

TESTING. I SAID THAT THE NATION WOULD BE WATCHING HOW WE MET

THE MANY CHALLENGES BEFORE US AT THAT TIME.

THOSE CHALLENGES WERE DEMANDING -- AND OUR RESPONSE HAS BEEN FORTHRIGHT AND POWERFUL.

IN THAT INAUGURAL ADDRESS, I ASKED THE PEOPLE OF NEW

JERSEY TO JOIN ME IN SUMMONING ALL OF OUR RESOURCES FOR THE

TASKS AT HAND. THEIR RESPONSE HAS BEEN A RESOUNDING BURST

OF PRIDE AND ENERGY THAT IS NOW SEEN AND FELT NOT ONLY IN OUR

STATE, BUT ACROSS THIS NATION.

TODAY, THREE YEARS AND SOME MONTHS LATER, NEW JERSEY IS

NO LONGER A FOLLOWER -- NEW JERSEY IS A LEADER.

I COME BEFORE YOU TODAY BECAUSE I'M VERY PROUD OF WHAT
NEW JERSEY HAS ACCOMPLISHED.

SINCE I TOOK THAT OATH IN JANUARY OF 1982, OVER 300,000

JOBS HAVE BEEN CREATED IN NEW JERSEY -- THE GREATEST EMPLOYMENT

SURGE IN FOUR DECADES.

WE'VE ADDED JOBS AT A RATE TWICE AS FAST AS THE COUNTRY
AS A WHOLE.

IN JANUARY OF 1982, OUR UNEMPLOYMENT RATE STOOD AT 9.2%,

FAR HIGHER THAN THE NATIONAL AVERAGE. WE'VE DROPPED THAT

RATE BY OVER THREE FULL PERCENTAGE POINTS -- AND IT IS NOW

MORE THAN A FULL POINT BELOW THE NATIONAL RATE.

I ENTERED OFFICE FACING A THREE BILLION DOLLAR BACKLOG

OF NEEDED TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS -- THIS AT A TIME WHEN

MUCH OF NEW JERSEY'S CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY LAY DORMANT.

WE HAVE ATTACKED THAT BACKLOG. IT IS BEING ELIMINATED,
ROAD BY ROAD, BRIDGE BY BRIDGE, ALL OVER THIS STATE.

TODAY OUR CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY IS BOOMING. IT IS

BUILDING NOT JUST ROADS AND BRIDGES -- BUT HOUSES AND OFFICE

BUILDINGS AND STORES.

VIRTUALLY EVERY ECONOMIC INDICATOR THE STATISTICIANS

KEEP IS AT A RECORD HIGH -- RETAIL SALES, NEW CAR SALES,

CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS, NEW BUSINESS INCORPORATIONS. THE

LIST GOES ON.

THE FACT IS THAT NEW JERSEY FACED A TREMENDOUS CHALLENGE.
WE'VE TURNED THAT CHALLENGE INTO A TREMENDOUS OPPORTUNITY.

WE CONFRONTED THE PROBLEMS IN OUR SCHOOLS WITH A COMPREHENSIVE
BLUEPRINT FOR EDUCATION REFORM IN NEW JERSEY -- A BLUEPRINT

DESIGNED TO ENCOURAGE BOTH TEACHERS AND STUDENTS ALIKE TO

REACH FOR EXCELLENCE; TO BREATHE NEW LIFE AND NEW IDEAS INTO

THE CLASSROOM BY ATTRACTING NEW TALENT; AND THEN TO GIVE OUR

SCHOOLS THE TOOLS THEY NEED

MORE POLICEMEN ON THE STREETS, AND BUILT THE PRISONS NECESSARY

TO ASSURE THAT CRIMINALS SERVE OUT THEIR FULL SENTENCES.

AS A RESULT, IN THE LAST THREE YEARS OUR CRIME RATE IS DOWN OVER 20%.

WE HAVE ASSAULTED OUR GARDEN STATE'S COMPLEX ENVIRONMENTAL PROBLEMS WITH A COMMITMENT TO A CLEAN NEW JERSEY.

WE HAVE BLAZED A PATH INTO AREAS WHERE OTHER STATES ARE
TAKING THEIR FIRST TIMID LOOK. WE HAVE BEGUN THE LONG,
DIFFICULT TASK OF CLEANING UP OUR TOXIC WASTES, AND AS BILL

AND WHO WOULD HAVE GUESSED THAT THIS YEAR'S DEBATE IN THE NEW JERSEY LEGISLATURE WOULD NOT BE OVER WHICH TAXES TO RAISE, BUT WHICH TAXES TO CUT -- NOT ABOUT REDISTRIBUTING WEALTH BUT ABOUT CREATING WEALTH -- NOT ABOUT SHARING PAIN BUT ABOUT INCREASING PROSPERITY.

WE CONFRONTED THE PROBLEMS IN OUR SCHOOLS WITH A COMPREHENSIVE BLUEPRINT FOR EDUCATION REFORM IN NEW JERSEY -- A BLUEPRINT DESIGNED TO ENCOURAGE BOTH TEACHERS AND STUDENTS ALIKE TO REACH FOR EXCELLENCE; TO BREATHE NEW LIFE AND NEW IDEAS INTO THE CLASSROOM BY ATTRACTING NEW TALENT; AND THEN TO GIVE OUR SCHOOLS THE TOOLS THEY NEED TO DO THE JOB. IT MUST BE INCLUSIVE NOT EXCLUSIVE -- THE PARTY OF THE WORKER

IN THE FACTORY, OF THE STUDENT STARTING COLLEGE, OF THE SMALL

BUSINESSMAN SEEKING TO EXPAND, OF BLACK AS WELL AS WHITE.

NEW JERSEY HAS COME A LONG WAY IN THREE YEARS.

ON THE COLD JANUARY DAY WHEN I RAISED MY HAND TO BE SWORN IN TO THIS GREAT OFFICE, NEW JERSEY FACED A TIME OF TESTING. I SAID THAT THE NATION WOULD BE WATCHING HOW WE MET THE MANY CHALLENGES BEFORE US AT THAT TIME.

THOSE CHALLENGES WERE DEMANDING --- AND OUR RESPONSE HAS BEEN FORTHRIGHT AND POWERFUL.

IN THAT INAUGURAL ADDRESS, I ASKED THE PEOPLE OF NEW JERSEY
TO JOIN ME IN SUMMONING ALL OF OUR RESOURCES FOR THE TASKS AT
HAND. YOUR RESPONSE HAS BEEN A RESOUNDING BURST OF PRIDE AND

TODAY OUR CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY IS BOOMING. IT IS BUILDING NOT JUST ROADS AND BRIDGES --- BUT HOUSES AND OFFICE BUILDINGS AND STORES.

THE FACT IS THAT NEW JERSEY IS IN THE MIDST OF AN ECONOMIC EXPLOSION --- AN EXPLOSION FUELED NOT BY GOVERNMENT, BUT BY THE VITALITY OF THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE.

THIS ADMINISTRATION BELIEVES IN HELPING THOSE WHO CREATE JOBS, NOT HINDERING THEM.

WE HAVE BLAZED A PATH INTO AREAS WHERE OTHER STATES ARE TAKING THEIR FIRST TIMID LOOK. WE HAVE BEGUN THE LONG, DIFFICULT TASK OF CLEANING UP OUR TOXIC WASTES, AND AS FORMER EPA ADMINISTRATOR BILL RUCKELSHAUS PUT IT, WE ARE ALREADY "LIGHT YEARS AHEAD OF ANY OTHER STATE."
