# ELECTION NIGHT

## NOVEMBER 5, 1985

THANK YOU.

I JUST RECEIVED A PHONE CALL FROM PETER SHAPIRO. AND IT LOOKS LIKE THE RESULTS ARE CLEAR.

BEFORE I GO ANY FURTHER, LET ME SAY A WORD ABOUT PETER SHAPIRO. HE WAGED A GOOD CAMPAIGN. A TOUGH CAMPAIGN. AND I THINK THIS STATE HAS A LOT MORE TO HEAR FROM PETER SHAPIRO IN THE FUTURE.

ON A NIGHT LIKE TONIGHT, YOU REALIZE THAT THERE ARE MANY PEOPLE TO WHOM YOU OWE AN AWFUL LOT -- BECAUSE WITHOUT THEM, THIS VICTORY WOULD NOT HAVE BEEN POSSIBLE. FIRST, I'D LIKE TO THANK MY FAMILY. THEY HAVE STOOD WITH ME, THEY HAVE SUPPORTED ME THROUGHOUT THESE PAST FOUR YEARS. IT HASN'T ALWAYS BEEN EASY, BUT THEY HAVE BEEN PATIENT.

I WOULD LIKE TO THANK MY CHIEF OF STAFF, GREG STEVENS, FOR HELPING TO GUIDE THIS SHIP OF STATE SO ABLY, AND THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE FRIENDS OF TOM KEAN, BILL PALATUCCI, FOR RUNNING WHAT I BELIEVE WAS THE BEST CAMPAIGN THIS STATE HAS EVER SEEN.

AND FINALLY, I WANT TO SAY A SPECIAL WORD OF THANKS TO SOMEONE WHO IS WATCHING FROM A HOSPITAL BED TONIGHT -- THAT'S ANDY CONSOVOY, MY POLITICAL DIRECTOR, WHO DID A GREAT JOB.

MOST OF ALL, I WANT TO THANK EVERY PERSON IN THIS ROOM FOR ALL THAT YOU DID TO BUILD THIS GREAT VICTORY TONIGHT.

I KNOW THAT THIS CAMPAIGN DIDN'T BEGIN THIS YEAR. IT BEGAN FOUR YEARS AGO, WHEN WE FIRST SET ABOUT TO TURN THIS STATE AROUND.

IT BEGAN WITH ALL OF YOU WHO HAVE WORKED WITH ME IN TRENTON AND ALL AROUND THIS STATE TO CREATE JOBS, TO IMPROVE OUR SCHOOLS, AND TO CLEAN UP THE ENVIRONMENT.

IT BEGAN WITH ALL OF YOU WHO WORKED, IN EVERY TOWN IN NEW JERSEY, TO BUILD A REPUBLICAN PARTY, FROM THE GRASSROOTS LEVEL, THAT WAS STRONG ENOUGH TO WIN TONIGHT, BRAVE ENOUGH TO EMBRACE NEW IDEAS, AND SMART ENOUGH TO INCLUDE <u>EVERYONE</u> IN THE COMMUNITY. THAT IS THE MESSAGE OF THIS ELECTION. THAT IF WE <u>INCLUDE</u> PEOPLE INSTEAD OF EXCLUDING THEM, WE CAN DO <u>ANYTHING</u>.

IT APPLIES TO US AS NEW JERSEYANS. AS AMERICANS. AND AS REPUBLICANS.

THAT JUST AS WE HAVE TURNED NEW JERSEY'S ECONOMY AROUND, TURNED OUR SCHOOLS AROUND, AND TURNED OUR IMAGE AROUND, WE CAN TURN ANY PROBLEM AROUND.

THAT JUST AS WE -- THE REPUBLICAN PARTY -- ARE A MAJORITY TONIGHT, WE CAN <u>BE</u> THE MAJORITY PARTY IN THIS STATE -- AND IN THIS NATION.

THAT THE PARTY THAT <u>CREATES</u> OPPORTUNITY FOR THE PEOPLE WILL BE GIVEN OPPORTUNITY BY THE VOTERS. YOU KNOW, TOMMORROW IS AN ANNIVERSARY THAT SHOULD MEAN SOMETHING TO ALL OF US.

ONE-HUNDRED AND TWENTY FIVE YEARS AGO TOMMORROW, THE CANDIDATE OF A BRAND NEW POLITICAL PARTY WAS ELECTED PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES.

THAT PARTY WAS THE REPUBLICAN PARTY, AND THAT MAN WAS ABRAHAM LINCOLN.

ABRAHAM LINCOLN PRACTICED THE POLITICS OF INCLUSIVENESS. IN FACT, HE WENT TO WAR TO KEEP THIS COUNTRY TOGETHER.

HE TAUGHT US A LESSON THAT WAS UNDERLINED HERE TONIGHT.

THAT IT DOESN'T MATTER WHETHER YOU COME FROM NORTH OR SOUTH, WHETHER YOU'RE BLACK OR WHITE -- THAT WE ARE STRONGEST, AS A STATE, AS A NATION, AND AS A PARTY, WHEN WE ARE UNITED.

THAT, AS LINCOLN SAID, IF WE ARE EVER DESTROYED, IT WILL NOT BE FROM WITHOUT, BUT FROM WITHIN.

WELL, NEW JERSEY IS UNITED TONIGHT AS NEVER BEFORE. I'M PROUD TO HAVE BEEN THE CATALYST FOR IT.

BUT NOW, TONIGHT, I WANT TO ASK ALL OF YOU TO <u>USE</u> OUR NEWFOUND STRENGTH IN THESE NEXT FOUR YEARS.

I ASK YOU TONIGHT TO JOIN ME IN MAKING NEW JERSEY ALL THAT IT <u>CAN</u> BE IN THIS AGE OF PRIDE.

I THINK WE CAN BE A STATE THAT IS <u>STRONG</u> ENOUGH TO ATTRACT JOBS, AND <u>COMPASSIONATE</u> ENOUGH TO PROVIDE FOR THOSE WHO -- FOR WHATEVER REASON -- CANNOT WORK.

I THINK WE CAN BE A STATE THAT IS <u>SMART</u> ENOUGH TO INVEST IN THE YOUNG, AND <u>WISE</u> ENOUGH TO PROTECT THE OLD AND INFIRM.

I THINK WE CAN BE A STATE THAT LOOKS FORWARD ENOUGH TO PROTECT OUR ENVIRONMENT, AND LOOKS BACK ENOUGH TO REMEMBER OUR PROUD HERITAGE.

AND I THINK WE CAN BE A STATE THAT IS THE ENVY OF <u>ALL</u> AMERICA; THAT CITY ON A HILL THAT BECKONS ALL WHO HAVE ENOUGH FORESIGHT TO FOLLOW ITS LIGHT.

YES, WE DID PROVE SOMETHING TONIGHT.

THIS ELECTION PROVES THAT PEOPLE OF ALL BACKGROUNDS, ALL POLITICAL PERSUASIONS, AND ALL AGES WILL COME TOGETHER IF THE CAUSE IS WORTHY AND EVIDENCE SOLID. OUR CAUSE IS BUILDING PRIDE IN NEW JERSEY, AND OUR RECORD SPEAKS FOR ITSELF.

THIS ELECTION PROVES THAT PEOPLE OF ALL RACES WILL SUPPORT A REPUBLICAN IF THAT REPUBLICAN <u>REPRESENTS</u> PEOPLE OF ALL RACES. WELL, OURS IS A VICTORY OF ALL THE PEOPLE -- AND OURS WILL BE A GOVERNMENT OF ALL THE PEOPLE.

THIS ELECTION PROVES, MOST OF ALL, THAT <u>NEW JERSEY</u> CANNOT BE STOPPED. THAT OUR POTENTIAL IS LIMITED ONLY BY OUR IMAGINATION. OURS IS A VICTORY THAT SAYS TO EVERYONE WHO WROTE OFF NEW JERSEY: "AIN'T NO STOPPIN' US NOW!"

ONE CLEAR NOVEMBER NIGHT, HE AND A FRIEND WATCHED WHEN A SHOWER OF METEORS FELL FROM THE SKY. LINCOLN'S YOUNG FRIEND WAS FRIGHTENED, BUT LINCOLN SAID: "LET'S NOT MIND THE FALLING METEORS, BUT LET'S KEEP OUR EYES ON THE STARS."

FOR TOO LONG, PEOPLE'S EYES WERE FOCUSED ON NEW JERSEY'S SUPPOSEDLY FALLING STAR -- THE SINKING METEOR.
