

PROPOSED OUTLINE FOR GOVERNOR'S SPEECH AT THE RAY MARSHALL FUND-RAISER

INTRODUCTION:

I AM PROUD TO BE HERE AT THE RUTGERS LABOR EDUCATION CENTER. JUST LAST MONTH I ANNOUNCED BEFORE THE COUNCIL OF CARPENTERS IN ATLANTIC CITY THAT RUTGERS AND THE TRADE UNION MOVEMENT HAVE AGREED TO FUND A HALF MILLION DOLLAR ADDITION TO THIS BUILDING AND THAT CONSTRUCTION WILL SOON BEGIN. IT WILL BE CALLED THE RALEIGH RAJOPPI WING, WHICH IS A FITTING TRIBUTE TO RALEIGH AND THE ENTIRE CARPENTERS TRADE. RALEIGH WAS PRESIDENT OF THE CARPENTERS UNION FOR 36 YEARS.

K-MART ANNOUNCEMENT TO BUILD 30 NEW STORES, BECAUSE BUSINESS CLIMATE IS GOOD IN NEW JERSEY AND IT IS GETTING BETTER.
4. "I REMEMBER BACK IN 1974, WE PUT TOGETHER AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY, WITH NO HELP FROM MY OPPONENT."
5. WE WERE DETERMINED TO PUT NEW JERSEY BACK ON ITS ~~FEET~~^{FEET}, EVEN THOUGH WASHINGTON WAS GIVING US LITTLE HELP IN COMBATTING THE WORST RECESSION SINCE THE GREAT DEPRESSION.
6. WE WERE DETERMINED TO PUT PEOPLE BACK TO WORK, TO CREATE JOBS.
7. THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY HAS ACCOMPLISHED A LOT FOR NEW JERSEY.
